Since 1987 Worcester Play Council has led, championed and influenced the role of play within Worcester City. The charity is run by committed volunteers and a play coordinator, working with a wide range of stakeholders across the city to facilitate play for 0-16 year olds.

What we mean by Play

Play is what children and young people do when they follow their own ideas and interests in their own way and for their own reasons. (DCMS, 2004)

Children's Right to Play

The right to play and informal recreation, for all children and young people up to 18 years of age, is contained in Article 31 of the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child, ratified by the UK government, 1991. The government has a duty under this Convention to protect and promote play. (Charter for Children's Play, Play England, 2009).

Statistics in **Worcester City**

Just under a quarter of the City's population is 0-16 years of age. Worcester Play Council engages with circa 15 organisations, of which 9,500 children are supported through quality play.
